

Grantee Pre-Qualification

Office of the Illinois State Fire Marshal



To be eligible for grants with the State of Illinois grantees must complete certain requirements.

Those requirements include:

- Registration in the federal SAM.gov system
- Setting up a grantee portal account

Please note that if you do not have a Federal EIN you MUST obtain one of these prior to completing any of the registration steps.

Registration in the federal SAM.gov system

You can check to see your entity status here if you already have a SAM.gov registration (<https://sam.gov/content/status-tracker>). You will need to use your SAM.gov user account to check your entity status.

If you are registered but your status is expired follow the directions on how to renew your entity when you check your registration status.

If you are not registered follow the steps on the next slides.

Registration in the federal SAM.gov system

After creating a SAM.gov account you need to register as an entity. You need to do a **complete registration**. You **do not** want to get a UEI only.

PLEASE NOTE THAT YOU MUST MAKE YOUR ENTITY SEARCHABLE. DO NOT OPT OUT OF THE PUBLIC SEARCH OR YOU WILL NOT BE IDENTIFIED AS IN GOOD STANDING ON THE STATE SYSTEM.

Please note that when you get to the type of registration you need to choose the option for "All Awards"

After you complete your SAM.gov registration **and have completed the validation process and received your UEI** you must register with the state grantee portal.
