OSFM Civilian Fire Death Information

Civilian Fire Deaths are to be reported to OSFM within 24 hours of incident. If the death is clearly the result of fire, record it as such in "Civilian Death" Module. If it is unclear at the time of incident, record the death information in the "Remarks" Section but do not complete the Death Module but follow up with the Coroner's Office to determine cause of death and update NFIRS accordingly. If death was fire related, the Death Module must be completed. If it is not fire related, provide info in Remarks Section but do not complete Death Module.
