Application to Register Sprayed Fire-Resistant Material Applicator

Before an individual begins work with sprayed fire-resistant material on steel structures, the individual must register as a Sprayed Fire-Resistant Material Applicator with the Office of the Illinois State Fire Marshal pursuant to the Illinois Sprayed Fire-Resistant Material Applicator Act [425 ILCS 75].

Submit: (Required)

- Submit a clear copy of a valid state issued driver's license, valid state issued ID with date of birth and address, or a valid passport. *Must be 18 years of age or older.*

Submit ONE of the Following: (Required)

- (1) A certificate of completion for a plasterer apprenticeship from the U.S. Department of Labor or a recognized State Apprenticeship Agency; or
- (2) An affirmative statement that the applicant has at least eight hours of training in the application of sprayed fire-resistant material, including on the job training, classroom training, or a combination thereof. The statement shall be signed by the individual and the applicant and their employer or instructor; or
- (3) Documentation of any other training or certification, approved by the Office of the Illinois State Fire Marshal, that is equivalent to (1) or (2).

The undersigned certifies that I have read the Sprayed Fire-Resistant Material Applicator Act [425 ILCS 75] and associated administrative rules. The undersigned further certifies that all information and documents submitted herewith are accurate, true, and complete.

Failure to sign this form, submit the necessary information, or provide attachments will cause a delay in the date in which this application is deemed submitted to the Office of the Illinois State Fire Marshal and will cause a delay in the date in which the Applicant may be registered to perform activity related to the spraying of fire-resistant material. Approval as an active registered Sprayed Fire-Resistant Material Applicator can and should be verified on our website.
