

Illinois Firefighter Memorial Paver Brick Application Reserve Your Brick Today

In 1993, the Illinois Fire Services Association unanimously agreed that a monument should be erected to serve as the official memorial to all firefighters in Illinois who gave their lives in the line of duty and to those firefighters who heroically serve with courage, pride and honor. This dream became a reality May 13, 1999, when the memorial was unveiled and dedicated before 2,500 members, families and friends of the fire service on the Southwest corner of the State Capitol lawn.

The sculptor for the memorial was commissioned to design and construct an original bronze work of art consisting of

life-size figures of firefighters in full protective clothing in action. The statues were created using the "lost wax" method of bronze casting and is finished in an antique bronze fire-on patina. The figures are situated on a 14 foot high cairn, consisting of Renaissance stone. There are 2,400 red paver bricks which are enclosed by a 2 foot wall with capstones.

The sponsorship of personalized bricks will allow members, families and friends of the fire service to be recognized and become part of the Memorial.
